Core training offer

Core Working Together

This training is for anyone that has a specific role or duties around safeguarding for children and young people. The aim is to ensure that professionals have the knowledge and skills to effectively work together to safeguard children and young people and understand their role within this.

Multi Agency Thresholds

This training gives an overview of Sandwell's Multi Agency Thresholds and continuum of support and how to apply them in order to support decision making to get the right support, in the right place, at the right time for children and families

Early Help training offer

EHM Basic and Advanced

EHM is the multi-agency recording system for professionals working with families with 2 or more unmet needs. The Basic training offers an overview of the system, searching, and adding basic case notes. The advanced session is for those that may be involved in Team Around the Family Plans or be the Lead Professional.

Lead Professional

This training covers the role of the lead professional, including the skills and knowledge to feel comfortable and confident taking on this role for a family

An introduction to Early Help

This eLearning session gives an introduction and overview of Early Help in Sandwell.

Neglect training offer

Neglect Awareness

This eLearning session is for all professionals that come in to contact with children and young people. It takes aprox 40 minutes to complete and covers a basic understanding of the 6 categories of neglect as well as what you can do about it

GCP₂

Graded Care Profile 2 is the chosen Neglect assessment tool in Sandwell. It is licenced by the NSPCC and it is used to measure the quality of care children are receiving from their parent/care giver.

Exploitation training offer

Childhood regained eLearning

There are 2 eLearning modules available that cover the basic information that all professionals working with children and young people need around child exploitation.

- 1- Child sexual exploitation
- 2- Child Criminal Exploitation

Childhood regained face to face session

This training aims to equip professionals with the knowledge and skills to respond appropriately to concerns around child exploitation. It gives professionals the tools to take a proactive approach, ensuring children and young people are safeguarded and feel able to engage with services

Sandwell's learning from CSPR's training offer

Hidden men-finding ways forward

Engaging with males who live in the home or have significant importance for children and young people is a priority in Sandwell as it is often found in CSPR's that this is not happening. This session addresses the concerns around engaging with men and its importance within safeguarding to get the best outcomes.

Working with resistance and disguised compliance

This training aims to increase knowledge and understanding of why families may not engage with professionals as well as equipping them with the skills to recognise and challenge where there is disguised compliance with services.

Journeying to a culturally competent, open and understanding workforce

This training aims to increase knowledge and understanding of why families may not engage with professionals as well as equipping them with the skills to recognise and challenge where there is disguised compliance with services.

Learning from CSPR- SC

This is an eLearning module looking at the thematic review that was completed following the murder of a 17 year old in 2021. The review discusses issues of disparity and disproportionality and how we can all work better together to tackle these issues for better outcomes.

Additional multi-agency training offer

Managing Allegations

This training is for anyone that manages the position of trust process within an organisation or service. The role of the LADO will be explored as well as the process and procedures that need to be followed following an allegation being made.

Private Fostering

This eLearning module is designed to give professionals an understanding of what private fostering is and what they need to do if they identify a private fostering arrangement for a child or young person.

ICON- babies cry you can cope

This eLearning module covers the basics around helping new parents to cope with a crying baby

Core Working Together refresher

This eLearning module can be completed by those with a safeguarding responsibility or duties as a refresher of the Core Working Together training. The full day training must have been attended in the last 2 years in order to complete the refresher module
